

** Upcoming Water Line Flushing **

Water Line flushing has been postponed over the last few years due to drought conditions, but it is a very important part of the District's maintenance program. With a full allocation the District will recommence our line flushing maintenance program. Our personnel will be flushing water lines in the District during the month of November. Early Spring Gardening Checklist

- @ Clean up flowerbeds
- ® Divide your perennials
- @ Add mulch around perennials
- ® Prune trees and shrubs
- Perform basic maintenance on your hardscaping
- ® Plant cool season vegetables





Mosquitoes, which hibernate over the winter, emerge to lay their eggs – usually in stagnant pools of water – as the temperature approaches 50 degrees Fahrenheit.

And the warmer the temperature the faster they hatch. At 50 degrees, mosquitoes can grow from egg to adult in around 40 days, while in temperatures over 77 degrees, it takes just four days for mosquitoes to grow to adulthood.

Depending on the species, mosquitoes live for a few days or a few weeks.
