Top Tips for Fire Safety

1. Install smoke alarms on every level of your home, inside bedrooms and outside sleeping areas.
2. Test smoke alarms every month. ...
3. Talk with all family members about a fire escape plan and practice the plan twice a year.
4. If a fire occurs in your home, GET OUT, STAY OUT and CALL 911 FOR HELP.

Defensible space, coupled with home hardening, is essential to improve your home's chance of surviving a wildfire.

- Remove all dead plants, grass and weeds (vegetation).
- Remove dead or dry leaves and pine needles from your yard, roof and rain gutters.
- Remove branches that hang over your roof and keep dead branches 10 feet away from your chimney.
- Trim trees regularly to keep branches a minimum of 10 feet from other trees

3 ways to save our water

1. **Recycle Indoor Water and Irrigate Your Garden.** Recycling indoor water to use outdoors can cut water use by 30%.
2. **Take 5-minute Showers.** Keeping showers under 5 minutes can save 12.5 gallons per shower when using a water-efficient showerhead.
3. **Wash Full Loads of Clothes and Dishes.**
Washer: saves 15–45 gallons per load.
Dishwasher: saves 5–15 gallons per load.

We are still in Stage 1 Drought Voluntary Water Reduction – And we need your help to conserve water.

- ❖ We encourage alternative day watering; evening and early morning watering for all members of our community.
- ❖ We ask that any new development postpones landscaping.
- ❖ We ask that you not fill new pools or ponds; topping off of existing pools is allowable.

We continue to blend well water into the Distribution System. This may introduce cloudiness to the water that is a natural byproduct of CO₂. The cloudiness will dissipate naturally after a few minutes. There are also high calcium deposits (hard water) which are not harmful but may create spots on your dishes. Using Jet-Dry in your dishwasher can prevent these spots.
