Fill Bathtub Halfway or Less

Filling up your bathtub halfway or less can save 17-25 gallons of water per person every bath.

Fix Leaks

Fixing leaks inside and outside the home can save 27 to 90 gallons of water each day.

Install High-Efficiency Toilets

Installing high-efficiency toilets can save 6-35 gallons per day.

Recycle Indoor Water and Irrigate Your Garden

Recycling indoor water to use outdoors can cut water use by 30%.

Take 5-minute Showers

Keeping showers under 5 minutes can save 12.5 gallons per shower when using a water-efficient showerhead.

Wash Full Loads of Clothes and Dishes

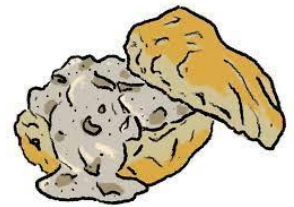
Washer: saves 15–45 gallons per load. Dishwasher: saves 5–15 gallons per load.

Turn Off Water When Brushing Teeth or Shaving

By turning off the water when brushing teeth or shaving you can save 8 gallons of water per person per day.

INFORMATION CONCERNING OPEN BURNING

You may now conduct normal burning operations without a burn permit on a permissive burn day in the Mountain Gate area.

Prior to conducting a burn, you must place a call to the Burn Number at (224-8777) no earlier than 9:15 am on the day you wish to burn to determine if it's a burn day. Burn days are determined by the State of California Air Quality Board. Please follow the burning guidelines below:

- All burning must be started no earlier than 10:00 am, and the fire must be out by 5:00 pm the same day.
- You must have a shovel and water available at the burn site for safety.
- You must have burnable material remove down to bare earth for a minimum distance of 10 feet surrounding the burn, with no overhanging limbs.
- Burn piles must be no larger than 4 feet in diameter, and there must be at least 10 feet between burn piles.
- You may only burn yard debris and trimmings, and never leave your burning pile unattended.
- You may not burn garbage, plastics, painted building materials, clothing, furniture, mattresses, or anything that is not yard trimmings.
