### **New Water Rates Became Effective on August 24, 2023**

Your new water billing will reflect the water rate increase that became effective on August 24, 2023. Only the base rate was increased. There was no change to over base charges.

#### **RESIDENTIAL**

For single-family dwellings, multiple family dwellings, the month base water service charge shall be:

<u>Meter Size</u>	<u>Service Charge</u>
Up to 3/4"	\$49.85 (This would include up to 500 cubic feet of water usage)
1"	\$62.58 (This would include up to 500 cubic feet of water usage)

The charge for water usage in excess of 500 cubic feet (1 CF = 7.48 gallons) shall be computed as follows:

<u>Water Usage</u>	<u>Amount</u>
From 501 - 2,000 CF	\$1.04 / 100 CF
From 2,000 - 10,000 CF	\$1.74 / 100 CF
From 10,000 – UP	\$2.06 / 100 CF

Each additional single-family dwelling served by one meter will be charged 10.52 per month. The first dwelling is included in the base water service charge in section 1 above.

#### **COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL**

For motels, hotels, apartment, mobile home parks, RV parks, commercial and industrial users, the monthly base water service charge shall be:

<u>Meter Size</u>	<u>Service Charge</u>
Up to 3/4"	\$72.58 (This would include up to 1500 cubic feet of water usage)
1"	\$85.07 (This would include up to 1500 cubic feet of water usage)
1 1/2"	\$101.05 (This would include up to 1500 cubic feet of water usage)
2"	\$115.16 (This would include up to 1500 cubic feet of water usage)
3"	\$157.83 (This would include up to 1500 cubic feet of water usage)
4"	\$206.45 (This would include up to 1500 cubic feet of water usage)

The charge for water usage in excess of 1500 cubic feet shall be computed as follows:

<u>Water Usage</u>	<u>Amount</u>
From 1501 – 2000	\$1.04 / 100 CF
From 2,000 - 10,000	\$1.74 / 100 CF
From 10,000 – UP	\$2.06 / 100 CF

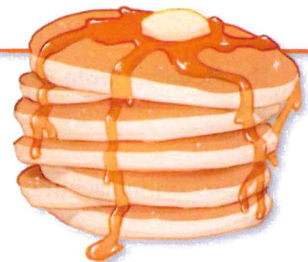
