#### 2023-2024 BUDGETS AND PROPOSED WATER RATE DISCUSSIONS

The Board of Directors have adopted the 2023-2024 Preliminary Water Department, Fire Department and CSD Budgets at the Board of Directors Meeting on April 12, 2023. The Staff also presented Proposed Ordinance 2023-01 Water Rates for 2023/2024 Budget. The Staff will be presenting the 2023-2024 Operating Budgets for consideration at the next Board of Directors Meeting of <u>June 14, 2023</u> at 6:00 pm. Water rates fund the delivery of drinking water, this includes planned construction, operation and the maintenance of our water infrastructure. It will continue to be our mission to provide the Mountain Gate Community with reliable, safe and clean water and fire protection services at the lowest cost possible. Proposed Ordinance 2023-01 is outlined as follows:

#### **RESIDENTIAL**

For single-family dwelling, multiple family dwellings, the monthly base water service charge shall be:

Up to 3/4" meter \$49.85 Base water service shall include 500 cubic feet of water usage. 1" meter \$62.58 Base water service shall include 500 cubic feet of water usage.

The charge for water usage in excess of 500 cubic feet shall be computed as follows:

From 501 to 2,000 cubic feet will be \$1.04 per 100 cubic feet. From 2,001 to 10,000 cubic feet will be \$1.74 per 100 cubic feet. From 10,001 cubic feet and up will be \$2.06 per 100 cubic feet.

Each additional single-family dwelling served by one meter will be charged \$10.52 per month. The first dwelling is included in the base water service fee.

#### **COMMERCIAL**

For motels, hotels, apartments, mobile home parks, R.V. Parks, commercial and industrial users, the monthly base water service charge shall be:

| Up to 3/4" | \$72.58 Base water service shall include 1500 cubic feet of water usage.  |

| 1"         | \$85.07 Base water service shall include 1500 cubic feet of water usage.  |
| 1 1/2"     | \$101.05 Base water service shall include 1500 cubic feet of water usage. |
| 2"         | \$115.16 Base water service shall include 1500 cubic feet of water usage. |
| 3"         | \$157.83 Base water service shall include 1500 cubic feet of water usage. |
| 4"         | \$206.45 Base water service shall include 1500 cubic feet of water usage. |

The charge for water usage in excess of 1,500 cubic feet shall be computed as follows:

From 1,501 to 2,000 cubic feet will be \$1.04 per 100 cubic feet. From 2,001 to 10,000 cubic feet will be \$1.74 per 100 cubic feet. From 10,001 cubic feet and up will be \$2.06 per 100 cubic feet.

Apartments and mobile homes served by one meter will be charged \$10.52 per month for each additional permanent space.

Motels, Hotels and RV Parks served by one meter will be charged \$5.50 per month for RV space or unit.

Commercial and Industrial users served by one meter will be charged \$10.52 per month for each additional building with sanitation facilities.

Defensible space, coupled with home hardening, is essential to improve your home's chance of surviving a wildfire.

- •Remove all dead plants, grass and weeds (vegetation).
- •Remove dead or dry leaves and pine needles from your yard, roof and rain gutters.
- •Remove branches that hang over your roof and keep dead branches 10 feet away from your chimney.
- •Trim trees regularly to keep branches a minimum of 10 feet from other trees
