

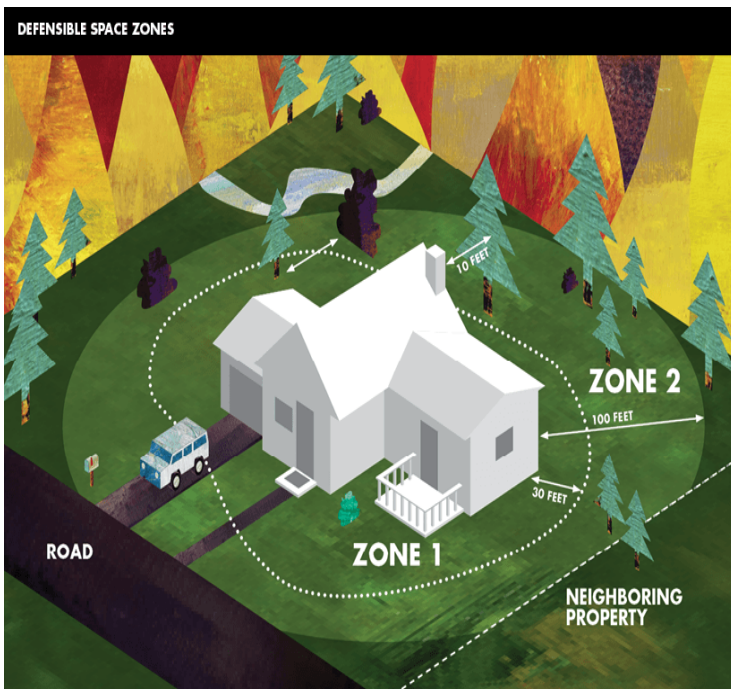
A DEFENSIBLE SPACE CAN SAVE YOUR PLACE

As the cooler weather approaches, don't let your guard down. It is still fire season with one of the deadliest California fires starting on November 8, 2018, the Camp Fire. Please make sure you have eliminated or reduced all combustible materials to slow the spread of fire within 30 feet (zone 1) of your home or any outbuildings. Additionally ensure well spaced shrubs and trees within 100 feet (zone 2) of your home and outbuildings. Reduce fuels that are farther than 100 feet from your home and outbuildings by thinning and pruning vegetation. Defensive space is one of the most cost effective ways to protect a building from wildfire.

Please report any illegal burning operations to 911 or CalFire (530) 225-2418

(open burning is not allowed during fire season which is from May 1st until the time it is declared over).

You may also report any hazardous fire conditions to CalFire.



Choose Fire-Resistant Plants and Materials

- Create fire-resistant zones with stone walls, patios, decks and roadways.
- Use rock, mulch, flower beds and gardens as ground cover for bare spaces and as effective firebreaks.
- There are no "fire-proof" plants. Select high-moisture plants that grow close to the ground and have a low sap or resin content.
- Choose fire-retardant plant species that resist ignition such as rockrose, ice plant and aloe.
- Select fire-resistant shrubs such as hedging roses, bush honeysuckles, currant, cotoneaster, sumac and shrub apples.
- Plant hardwood, maple, poplar and cherry trees that are less flammable than pine, fir and other conifers.
