Mosquitoes, which hibernate over the winter, emerge to lay their eggs – usually in stagnant pools of water – as the temperature approaches 50 degrees Fahrenheit.

And the warmer the temperature the faster they hatch. At 50 degrees, mosquitoes can grow from egg to adult in around 40 days, while in temperatures over 77 degrees, it takes just four days for mosquitoes to grow to adulthood.

Depending on the species, mosquitoes live for a few days or a few weeks.
