You may now conduct normal burning operations without a burn permit in the Mountain Gate area.

Prior to conducting a burn, you must place a call to the Burn Number at (224-8777) no earlier than 9:15 am on the day you wish to burn to determine if it's a burn day. Burn days are determined by the State of California Air Quality Board.
