BURN PERMITS ARE REQUIRED IN ALL AREAS OF SHASTA COUNTY

Please note: Effective Thursday, November 12, 2020, the burn permit suspension in Shasta and Eastern Trinity counties has been lifted for outdoor residential burning within the State Responsibility Area of Shasta and Trinity Counties.

In cooperation with the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, the Shasta County Fire Department is dedicated to the protection of life, property, and natural resources in Shasta County through cost-effective planning, prevention, support and emergency services. Services include (and are not limited to) structural fire suppression, wildland fire suppression, response to hazardous materials incidents, search and rescue, water rescue, vehicle extrication, technical rescue as well as basic life support medical services, campfire permits, Christmas tree permits, and educational materials.

Residents who wish to burn yard debris must follow any requirements for burn permits and burn restrictions in their area. For burning inside the fire districts of Redding/Buckeye, Shasta Lake, Anderson, and Cottonwood one should contact their district's fire department. In other areas of Shasta County, one should contact their local fire authority or CAL FIRE. The Shasta County Air Quality Management District provides permissive burn day information.
