Save Water Rain or Shine

- Inspect irrigation systems and check for leaks and broken or clogged sprinkler heads.
- Fix sprinkler heads that are broken or spraying on the sidewalk, street, or driveway.
- **Did you know?**
- Just one broken sprinkler head can waste up to 25,000 gallons of water over a six-month irrigation season.
- Grass doesn't always need water just because it's hot out. Step on the lawn, and if the grass springs back, it doesn't need water.
- Pipes expand and contract as the temperature changes between night and day. This added stress means you are likely to develop a leak over the winter.
