**Mountain Gate Community Services District Water System
Improvements Project**

Mountain Gate has just completed phase 1 of the Water System Improvement Project, this was funded by the State Water Resources Control Board Drinking Water State Revolving Fund.

Proposed Improvement include:

- Replacement of approximately 15,000 feet of 6 inch water main with 12 inch water main and replacement of associated water services along Old Oregon Trail, generally between the northern end of Old Oregon Trail to the northeastern boundary of the Redding City limits.
- Replacement of existing 4 inch water main with 6 to 8 inch water main in Copper Canyon Road, Grande Vista Lane, Welbula Drive, El Teda Lane, and Casa Drive.
- Construction of approximately 3,000 feet of 8 inch water main in the southernmost segment of Sunrise Drive.
- Improvements on the South Tank site, including installation of an 8 inch parallel water main between the tank and Holiday Road and miscellaneous piping improvements.
- Installation of approximately 22 new or replacement fire hydrants in various locations throughout the MGCS D water service area.
- Installation of three new pressure reducing valves including a 12 inch PRV on Old Oregon Trail, a 6 inch PRV on Naomi Lane, and an 8 inch PRV on Casa Drive.
- Installation of a new emergency intertie with the Bella Vista Water District at the southern extent of proposed water main improvements on Old Oregon Trail.

A hydraulic analysis completed in conjunction with the MGCS D's Master Water Plan indicates that small diameter waterlines limit maximum fire flows that can be achieved in some areas. The Master Water Plan identifies near-term and long-term improvements that are needed to address system deficiencies. The planned improvements are identified as long-term improvements.

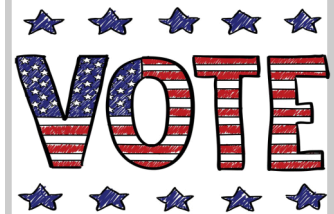
