Looking for a yummy mother's day breakfast? Try this Breakfast Bake!

You will need:

- 2 large potatoes shredded into hash browns
- 6 large eggs
- 1 cups milk
- 1 cups shredded co-jack cheese
- 1 cup diced ham
- Salt and pepper
- ¼ Cup sliced green onion

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350°F grease a 9x9 deep baking or [casserole dish](#).
Pour the hashbrowns in the baking dish and spread out into an even layer.

Lightly [salt](#) and pepper the hashbrowns.

Sprinkle one cup of the cheese over the hashbrowns.
Sprinkle the ham over the cheese.

In a [large bowl](#), beat 6 eggs.
Stir in milk, [salt](#) and pepper.
Pour the mixture over the hashbrowns, as evenly as possible.

Sprinkle sliced green onion and the remaining cheese over top.
Bake for 55-65 minutes or until deep golden brown. Check by inserting a butter knife in the center, if it comes out clean it's done.
Let rest 10 minutes. **Enjoy!**

What happens if a mosquito bites you?

A mosquito bite injects saliva into the skin, causing an immune response that creates itchy, red, swollen bumps. While often just a minor irritation lasting a few days, bites can lead to secondary infections from scratching, allergic reactions (Skeeter syndrome), or transmission of diseases like West Nile virus, Zika, or Malaria

What happens if a mosquito bites your pet?

Mosquito bites on pets can cause painful, itchy skin irritations or allergic reactions, but the most severe danger is the transmission of life-threatening **heartworm disease**. A single bite from an infected mosquito can introduce immature worms into a dog or cat, causing permanent damage to the heart, lungs, and arteries.
