## **OPEN BURNING HAS BEEN SUSPENDED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE DUE TO LARGE FIRE ACTIVITIES**

Open burning is **normally** allowed from November 1, 2017 to April 30, 2018. C.D.F. will announce through the media when Fire Season is over and open burning is allowed.

Keep in mind that even when burning is allowed, the information you get by calling the "Burn Day Number **(530) 224-8777** only tells you if you can burn from an air quality standpoint. That does not mean it is safe to burn. You must always see to the safety of your burning operations. Here are some suggestions as we approach the open burning and wood heating season.

- 1) Inspect and clean your wood burning stove or fireplace and flue system carefully.
- 2) Be sure to use dry wood, higher moisture contributes to creosote build-up in the flue.
- 3) Clean your gutters and inspect them regularly throughout the year.
- 4) When doing open burning, follow all guidelines. Violators can be fined \$200 to \$1,000 dollars. Also keep a garden hose near your fire along with a shovel. Do not leave your fire unattended. Burn permits are not required in Mountain Gate.
- 5) Start planning now how you can make your home fire safe for the next year. Plan weed control, fuel reduction and emergency planning.
