The District has had many improvements over the past 10 years. The District has received over **3.2 million in grants** to cover the costs of some of the improvements. **Prior to 2008** the District had received **no grant funding**. The Board of Directors and the staff has been working closely with PACE Engineering on DWSRF Prop 1 funding for improvements to 16,000 feet of 6 to 12 inch water main with additional fire hydrants. The Board and staff are also looking at funding for solar power. With the continued support of the Board of Directors and our customers, we will continue to provide reliable, safe and clean drinking water and fire protection to our customers.
